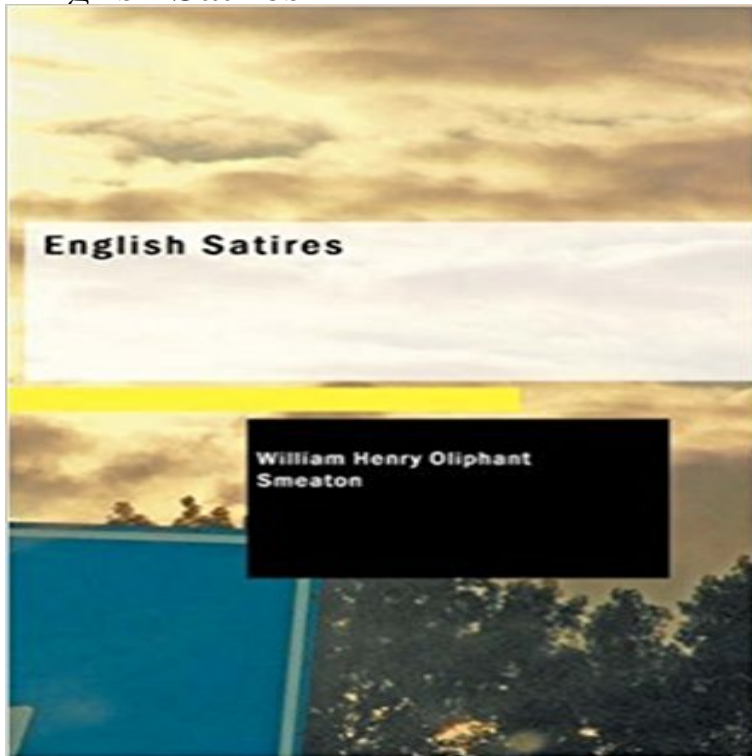


English Satires
