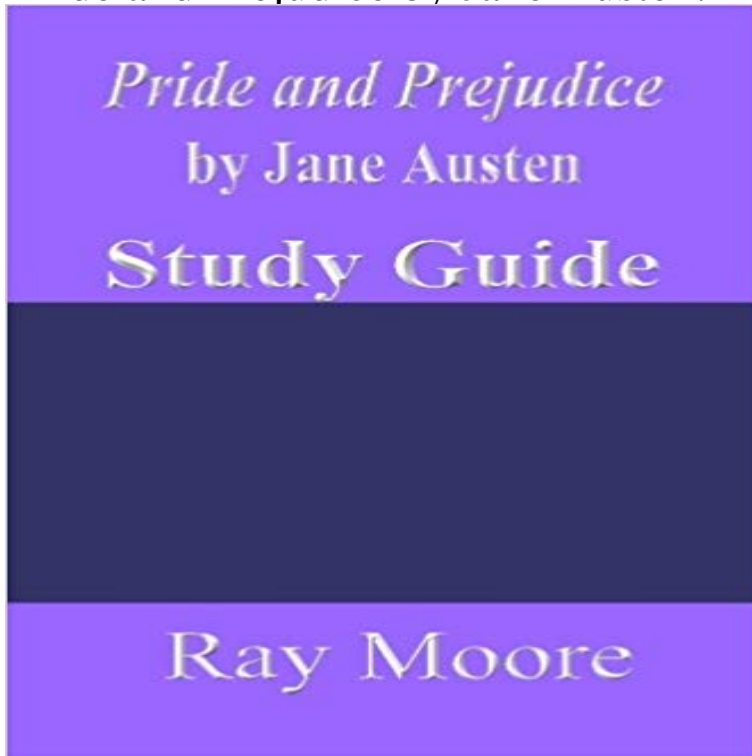


## Pride and Prejudice by Jane Austen: A Study Guide (Volume 42)
